



Frostview Road Reconstruction

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: There are two parts to the project and will affect everyone who uses Frostview Road.

PART 1: Beginning June 22, 2020, the pavement will be removed on Frostview Road from Great Northern Drive to County Road 83 and grading will be completed to improve the ditch slopes in some areas. After the grading has been completed, the gravel will be replaced. The road will remain with gravel surfacing for a period of 2 to 4 weeks before it is paved.

PART 2: Frostview Road from Great Northern Drive to the south dead end will receive a bituminous overly and shouldering. This portion of the roadway will begin at the same time the second lift of bituminous is placed on the north end of the project. The paving portion of this segment will be completed in 1 to 2 days after starting and shouldering will be completed within a week of paving.

SHOULDERS: For both segments of the project, the type of shouldering will be as follows: If you mow your lawn to the street edge you will receive topsoil and seed, and if the area is not mowed the shoulder will be gravel.

CONTRACTOR: The prime contractor for this project is Knife River Corporation and the grading subcontractor is Gertken Bros., Inc. from Richmond.

TRAFFIC CONTROL: The roadway will be open to local traffic throughout the workday, with minor delays. Please be patient until the roadway is clear before proceeding. There will be periods during the project when the gravel has been removed and you will be driving on sand. Be aware that car travel may be difficult at times. Safety of the workers and traveling public is very important so please be careful and make sure that you have made eye contact with an equipment operator or other worker before proceeding into the construction area.

MAILBOXES: The mailboxes located on Frostview Road will be temporarily moved to the Town Hall parking lot during construction where they will be erected in a line along the gravel drive to the south of the Town Hall. The mailboxes will be replaced after the shouldering work has been completed. Some of the locations may change slightly based on comments from the Postmaster. All boxes for other streets will remain in place during construction.

FIRE NUMBERS: Some of the fire numbers along Frostview Road will be taken down at some time to allow grading and paving to occur. If your fire number is removed, it will be placed out of the way temporarily to allow work and replaced after the project is completed.
